We are very pleased that we are able to have an evening that we consider to be an important component to setting your child up for a successful year.

The aim of the night is to allow parents and teachers to get together as a group so that teachers can let you know some of the routines and expectations of their classroom. It also allows parents the opportunity to ask any questions for the teachers that you may have as well as hopefully make some connections with parents you may not have met previously.

# WELCOME TO OUR CLASSROOM!

### The structure of the Night:

CLASSROOM ESO/PLAYGROUP COORDINATOR

- Each teacher will speak one after the other at different times, so if you have children in different classes you will be able to hear all of them.
- The night will start at 5:30pm for The Reception/Year I class in the classroom.
- 5:45pm BBQ sausages will be served for all parents.
- 5:45pm the Year 2 class will have their session in the classroom. (you can get your sausages after the session)
- 6:00pm the Year 3/4 class will have their session in the classroom.
- 6:15pm the Year 5/6 class will have their session in the classroom.

There will not be anything after your class session so you are free to go whenever your session is done, but you are also most welcome to stick around for a while and mix and mingle with other parents.

#### **SCHOOL ORGANISATION**

To support the safety of children and school organisation the following issues need to be communicated:

**Drop off/Collection:** Please farewell and pick-up children on the playground side of the school as bus transportation on West Terrace has priority.

**Student Absence:** If your child is absent from school, or going to be absent, please contact the front office. DO NOT contact a class teacher via text or Seesaw app.

**Sign in:** A Parent must sign your child in at the front office if they are late to school (anytime after 9:00am). Parents will also need to sign children in/out if they have appointments.

**School Lunch Orders:** Lunch orders are available every Monday and Wednesday from Gladstone High School via the QKR app.

**School Fees**: Statements for all families will be sent out as soon as possible. Outstanding 2023 fees must be paid immediately or contact the Principal regarding this matter within the next 7 days.

There was a fee payment option letter sent out at then end of last year, if you have not returned this it is important that you return this by Friday 9th February so that we know how you will be paying your fees this year.

- <u>-Term 1:</u> Week 2 Fee statement is issued to all families
- -Term 2: Week 2 Outstanding accounts sent out .
- -Term 3: Week 2 Final account sent out for outstanding fees. Fees to be paid in full by the end of Term 3.

**Tissues:** Each child is required to bring a box of tissues for their classroom. Please present these to the front office for labelling.

**Mobile Phones**: The use of mobile phones/devices by students for personal usage is not permitted at school. If your child is in need of a mobile phone/device for parental contact after they have left the school grounds the phone must be turned into the front office first thing in the morning and collected at the end of the day.

**Labels:** Please label <u>all clothing</u> and school items belonging to your child. The beginning of a school year means many new items all look the same to the children if they are not labelled.

### **2024 SCHOOL CARD INFORMATION**

<u>The State Government have raised the School Card income threshold</u> to help families with the cost of living. This means that families with one child and a gross combined income of \$70,994 or less for the 2022/23 financial year will be able to apply for School Card. The gross income increases depending on the number of school aged children. You are able to apply online or applications are available at the front office.

Our fee policy states that families eligible for school card receive 40% reduction on their tuition fees. School card applications are done online via the website.

### **CATHOLIC IDENTITY**

Every year, the Schools in the Port Pirie Diocese adopt a theme to guide our focus. This year, our chosen theme is 'Let Your Light Shine'. This theme encourages us to embrace God's mission, to ignite the flame within ourselves, and to be a beacon of light in all aspects of God's creation.
