

ENROLMENTS FOR 2024

We are currently organising our class numbers for 2024. We would appreciate any anticipated changes in enrolments to be communicated to the front office as soon as possible. We also ask that an Application for Enrolment form be filled out for any new children starting in 2024 (both at the beginning of the year and mid-year intake). These can be picked up from the front office at any time. Please be aware that we have a TWO INTAKE POLICY. The criteria for starting Reception on the first day of school in Term 1 continues to be that the child will attain the age of 5 on or before 30 April in that year.

- The criteria for starting Reception on the first day of school in Term 3 is that the child will have attained the age of 5 on or before 31 October in that year.
- Children starting in Reception in Term 3 will have a minimum of 6 terms in Reception
- Children whose birthday falls between 1 November and 31 December are not eligible to commence school before the following year. Please call the front office if you have any question regarding enrolments.
